The Arnhold Graduate Dance Education Program offers two-degree programs for ambitious artists and educators looking for challenge, personal growth and professional advancement.

5-Year BA/MA in Dance Education

This accelerated BA/MA is a five-year program designed to attract highly motivated students who are interested in teacher certification in dance and who wish to prepare themselves with a solid liberal arts undergraduate degree.

Our consolidated plan of study allows students to complete both their undergraduate and graduate degrees in Dance Education in less time than traditional degree programs.

BA/MA candidates demonstrate potential for growth in dance artistry (technique, improvisation, choreography, and performance) as well as academic success.

MA in Dance Education

The Masters in Dance Education program prepares dance artists and educators for the demands of teaching the history, culture, and practice of dance in Pre-K-12 classrooms, while providing students with the coursework required for professional certification for teaching dance in New York State.

- **Track One:** Applicants must have a liberal arts bachelor's degree that satisfies the general education requirements of Hunter's School of Education and a minimum of 34 credits in dance.
- **Track Two:** Applicants must have initial K-12 certification in dance from New York State.
- **Track Three:** Applicants must have initial or permanent/professional certification in any field as well as a minimum of 34 credits in dance.
