Re: Exchange Programs

The Art Department offers exchange programs with the Ecole Nationale Superiore de Beaux Arts, Paris; The Slade School of Fine Art, University College, London; Hochschule der Kunste, Berlin; the Academie Minerva, Groningen, Holland; the Glasgow School of Art, in Scotland and Royal College of Art, London, England.

The exchange period is for one semester only; programs of study will be determined individually. Any participating Hunter student must register for 6 credits at Hunter for the particular semester. Ideally, students should be in their junior or beginning senior year when they participate in the exchange program in their last semester of the 42-credit major. All tuition and fees are payable directly to Hunter. Additional costs to students will be for transportation, living expenses and materials.

Scholarship money has been made available in past years to help defray the costs of participation. Students going to Paris/Berlin who have not already studied French/German should plan on an intensive course before departure in order to achieve some level of proficiency in speaking the language. The language used for exchange students in Holland is English.

We invite all qualified students who wish to apply for the coming academic year, Fall 2008 and Spring 2009, to submit the enclosed application form to the Art Department no later than April 18, 2008. Students should discuss the relevancy of foreign study to their work with their current professors and department advisors.
