** Accelerated study fees are charged to undergraduate students ONLY taking > 18 credits.

*** All graduate students taking classes that have more contact hours than credit hours pay an excess contact hour charge. For example if a 3-credit class meets 5 hours a week, a NY State resident student pays \$65 per excess contact hour (\$130 for 2 extra hours) and a non-NY State resident pays \$85 per excess contact hour (\$170 for 2 extra hours).

**** Charged to Graduate students ONLY who need to maintain their matriculation because they are not enrolled in classes in the term they plan to graduate in.
