### ABOUT CATALYST

### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- U.S. citizen or legal permanent resident
- Declared major in Environmental Earth Science, Computer Science, Mathematics, Statistics or Physics
- Completion of at least 60 college credits and a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Demonstrated financial need via a FAFSA application
- Intention to pursue a career in established or emerging fields within science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM).
