The following are some significant changes in the PSC-CUNY 35 Guidelines.

In order to provide maximum assistance to faculty whose research is underfunded, faculty with more than \$200,000 per year in funding for their own research in the Life & Earth Sciences and Physical Sciences division (excluding fellowships and instrumentation grants), or with more than \$100,000 per year in funding for their own research in the Arts & Humanities, Interdisciplinary and Social Sciences divisions as of October 15, 2003, are ineligible to apply.

All PSC-CUNY applicants are recommended to submit an application via the e-application system. PSC-CUNY 35 is the last cycle that paper applications will be accepted

The maximum amount of \$8,000 may be requested for PSC-CUNY awards.

A principal investigator is eligible to receive summer salary only if his/her annual salary and summer salary combined does not exceed \$61,111.

Travel destinations approved in the budget must not be changed without approval of the UCRA prior to travel.

Equipment (over \$1000) must be an approved budget item on your grant. Requests for budget reallocation for equipment cannot be made after purchase. Please be sure that award has adequate funds before purchase, we do not encumber small order forms

Research Foundation Purchase cards are not issued for PSC-CUNY grants.
