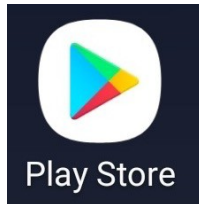
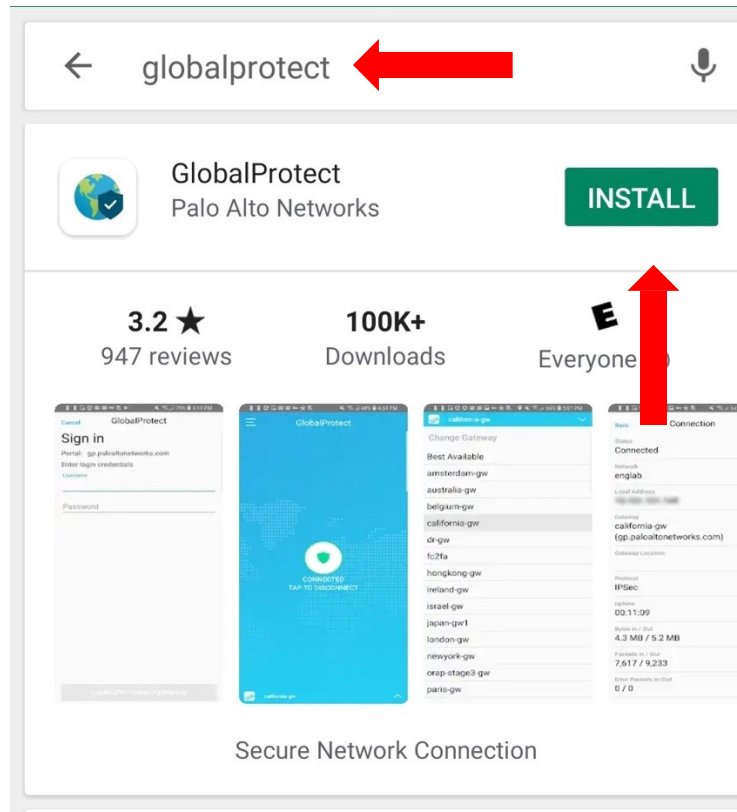


GlobalProtect VPN for Android Devices

1. Open the Play Store by tapping on the icon



2. Then Search for **“Global Protect”** and tap on **“INSTALL”** to Download the App.



3. Look for the Global Protect app on your Home Screen and launch it.



4. Type “vp5.hunter.cuny.edu” as the portal address and then tap on “**Connect**”.
