**POST – MASTER’S ADVANCED CERTIFICATE IN NURSING EDUCATION**

Hunter-Bellevue School of Nursing of the City University of New York, CUNY offers an advanced certificate nursing education program for registered nurses who hold a master’s degree in nursing from an accredited school. The program prepares nurses for beginning positions as educators in both academic settings and health care agencies. The 13 credit program consists of four courses, one of which is a 4 credit practicum including 135 hours of preceptored practice teaching. The program courses will be offered in four consecutive semesters. A previous graduate course in nursing theory is the pre-requisite to the first course in the sequence.

**Course of Study**

Courses progress from the teaching-learning process to program development and culminate with actual education practice. Instructional design (N 730) covers characteristics of the learner, the teaching process, and practice in presenting actual classes. The course on assessment (N 701) covers educational measurement at the individual level. The course in advanced concepts (N 752) looks at program development and accreditation criteria. The use of technology to enhance education will be stressed in all courses. The last course is a practicum in nursing education. Students will be placed with educators in community and senior colleges or departments of nursing education for 135 hours (N 731). They will be expected to develop objectives and to work closely with a designated preceptor.

An earned specialty master’s degree in nursing from an accredited college with an overall GPA of 3.0 or better.</li> <li>2. License and current registration to practice professional nursing in New York State.</li> <li>3. Professional resume listing relevant educational and work experience.</li> <li>4. Statement of purpose identifying why the applicant is interested in teaching and relevant clinical specialization experiences.</li> <li>5.
