MASTER'S PROGRAM—PSYCHIATRIC-MENTAL HEALTH NURSE PRACTITIONER

This 48-credit program prepares nurses for roles as advanced practice registered nurses delivering psychiatric and mental health services. Psychiatric/mental health nurse practitioners provide mental health treatment, preventive services, consultation and leadership in hospitals, clinics, community settings and private practice. Through coursework and 630 hours of supervised clinical experience, students learn to provide these services autonomously and in collaboration with other mental health professionals. Graduates of this program meet the educational requirements for board certification by the American Nurses Credentialing Center. They are also eligible for New York State NP certification.

- Licensure and current registration as an RN in • New York State
- Cumulative undergraduate GPA of 3.0 overall ٠ and in nursing coursework
- Completion of a basic statistics course and an • undergraduate research course
- Completion of an online application form
- A personal statement and at least two relevant letters of recommendation
- 2 years post-baccalaureate full time registered nursing experience required
