The following is the program plan for the AGNP program. The AGNP program is part-time study.

Clinical Requirements: Please be advised the clinical courses, Primary Care 1, 2, & 3 require completion of 210 precepted clinical hours during the semester. *Individual scheduling requests, ie weekend only, cannot be accommodated.* Students are expected to actively participate in identifying clinical sites and preceptors. *Students with restricted or specific scheduling needs must find their own placement that can accommodate their individual schedule.*

Health Clearance information is processed through CastleBranch. You will receive information about registering for an account in the semester prior to clinical.

Fall	Theoretical Foundations of Nursing Science (N700) <u>AND</u> one other “core” course: Health Promotion & Disease Prevention in Diverse Populations (N749) <i>OR</i> Healthcare Systems & Policy (N704)	Special permission may be given to take Theory and Research in the same semester
Spring	Advanced Nursing Research (N702) <u>AND</u> one other “core” course: Health Promotion & Disease Prevention in Diverse Populations (N749) <i>OR</i> Healthcare Systems & Policy (N704)	
Fall	Advanced Pathophysiology (N717) <i>AND</i> Advanced Pharmacotherapeutics (N750)	Recommended taken together
Spring	Advanced Health Assessment (N751) (includes lab)	This course must be taken in the semester immediately preceding the Primary Care Clinical Course Health Clearance documentation is required
Summer	Primary Care Nursing One (N755)	<u>Only</u> offered in Summer
Fall	Primary Care Nursing Two (N757)	Only offered in Fall
Spring	Primary Care Nursing Three (N768)	Only offered in Spring
