Enrollment is limited to 20 participants. Certification is offered through a three part series of three-day courses. Part II is scheduled for Feb 8-10, 2013 and Part III is scheduled for April 12-14, 2013. Participants must complete Part I to register for Part II and must complete Part II to register for Part III. Open to licensed Physical Therapists or MD's. Passing a written and practical exam on the last day of Part III provides certification as a Schroth Scoliosis Therapist.

Cancellation Policy: If a participant cancels registration up to 14 days prior to the start of the course, there will be a \$100.00 cancellation penalty. For cancellations less than 14 days, there will be a \$150 penalty. You may transfer assignment of the seat at no penalty. In the event that the host must cancel this course, a full refund will be issued.
