	"RESOLVED, That as of June 1973 any student who is presently registered at Hunter College may repeat a course previously taken, in which he has earned a grade of D, F or NC (no credit). After the course has been completed a second time and the grade reported, only the better grade received will be used for all official Hunter College purposes; in particular, the lower grade will not be counted in computing the grade point average, nor in determining the status of a student on probation or being considered for loss of matriculation. The lower grade and corresponding credit for the course in question will remain on the student's official transcript, but will be crossed out and marked "repeated". It should be noted that all credits so taken will count towards the maximum allowable tuition free credits.
