 21 that undergraduate academic courses which are to be offered by any unit of Hunter college
 22 that does not offer an approved major, minor, or certificate program are to be considered in
 23 terms of how they may complement Hunter College's approved major, minor, or certificate
 24 programs in the context of the College's overall educational goals. A course proposal by a
 25 unit of Hunter College without an approved major, minor, or certificate program therefore is
 26 to be submitted to the Divisional/School curriculum committee(s) of the discipline(s) which
 27 the proposed course is to complement. The unit proposing the course shall be invited to
 28 send one or more representative(s) to the appropriate divisional/school curriculum
 29 committee(s). After going through one or more of those curriculum committees, as
 30 appropriate, the course proposal may then be brought to the Senate Undergraduate Course
 31 of Study Committee and the Senate for approval.
