This two-day training supports the Life Skills Toolbox. Participants receive the new resource and learn how to utilize competencies and performance indicators when designing life skill instruction. They learn how to create effective learning environments and to use the toolbox to design life skill groups and individual instruction. Participants are introduced to the use of portfolios as a way to document progress.

This training is only available to staff who are responsible for the design and delivery of life skill groups. During the training participants create action plans, which are used by Center staff to conduct follow-up technical assistance.
