The Distribution Requirement

All students who matriculated at Hunter College between Fall 1986 and Spring 2001 are responsible for the Distribution Requirement (DR), a set of competencies, knowledge areas, and perspectives in the liberal arts: Science and Quantitative Reasoning, English Composition, Foreign Language, Literature, Humanities and the Arts, and Social Sciences. In addition, all students, including transfer students, matriculating in Fall 1993 or later, must complete 3 credits in each of four Pluralism and Diversity groups, for a total of 12 credits.

Note: If you matriculated in Fall 2001 or thereafter, you are responsible for completion of the General Education Requirement (GER). If you matriculated prior to Fall 1986, you should meet with an advisor/counselor in the Office of Student Services (1119 East Building.)

DR Regulations

Basic Regulations

- Only one of the courses used to satisfy the requirements for a major may be used to satisfy the distribution requirement. Foreign language majors should refer to the major departments for specific distribution requirements. Correlative requirements for the major may be credited to the distribution requirement.
- No more than two courses per department or program may be applied to satisfy the distribution requirement. Exceptions to this are ENGL 120, which is required of all students, and the foreign language requirement.
- A course may be applied to satisfy the requirements in only one category of the distribution requirement.
- Students who have demonstrated mastery of lower-level course material, to the satisfaction of the chair of the department involved or his/her designate, will be permitted to apply more advanced courses to fulfill the distribution requirement.

Foreign Language Regulations

The requirement of four semesters of language courses or an equivalent combination of college and high school courses is fulfilled only if all four semesters are completed in the same language.

Pluralism and Diversity Regulations

All students, including transfer students, matriculating at Hunter in Fall 1993 or later, must complete 3 credits in each of four Pluralism and Diversity groups, for a total of 12 credits. All courses used to satisfy Pluralism and Diversity requirements may simultaneously meet Core requirements or courses necessary for a major or minor. *Example:* MUSHL 101 satisfies Category V, Group 1, **AND** Pluralism and Diversity, Group D.
