- Letter of Acceptance from Hunter Admissions Office
- Visit the MyChoice website to confirm attendance: mychoice.hunter.cuny.edu
- The Admissions office begins to evaluate your transfer credits
- Invited to orientation/advising session when Transfer Credit Evaluation is complete
- Register for classes via E-SIMS!

Transfer Credits

Hunter equivalent classes

- Appear as:

- ENGL 120 class title # of credits
- PSYCH 100 class title # of credits

- This is a course that has the same curriculum as a Hunter Course
- Hunter equivalent's are listed with department name and course number
- May be used to fulfill General Education Requirements (GER)

Transfer Credits

General Education equivalents

- Appear as:

- GE2B course title # of credits
- GE3A course title # of credits
- Courses that had a similar curriculum to a Hunter Course
- May be used to fulfill General Education Requirements
- GE=General Education
- The number (1,2,or 3) corresponds to a particular stage in the Core Requirement
- The Letter (A, B, C, D or E) corresponds to a section within the identified Stage of the Core Requirements

Transfer Credits Electives

- Appear as:

- ELECT course name # of credits

- Count toward total credit balance

- You need at least 120 total credits to graduate

Transfer Credits

Electives continued:

- Elective courses may potentially be changed to Hunter equivalent courses
- Take the course description and/or syllabus to the corresponding department for evaluation
- Take “Course Equivalent” form to Admissions (203 HN)
- Your transcript will then be updated by the Admissions Office

Majors and Minors

- You do not transfer to Hunter with a major. At the time of application, you only indicated an intended area of study
- You will declare a major in your academic department when you meet with a Faculty Advisor
- A major must be declared by your 61st credit
- Your major department also controls your minor
