Regulations: Matriculation

- You must be a fully matriculated Hunter College student prior to attempting your 24th credit at Hunter College

Regulations: Immunization

- Proof of immunization is required by New York State Law for students registering for **6 or more credits**.

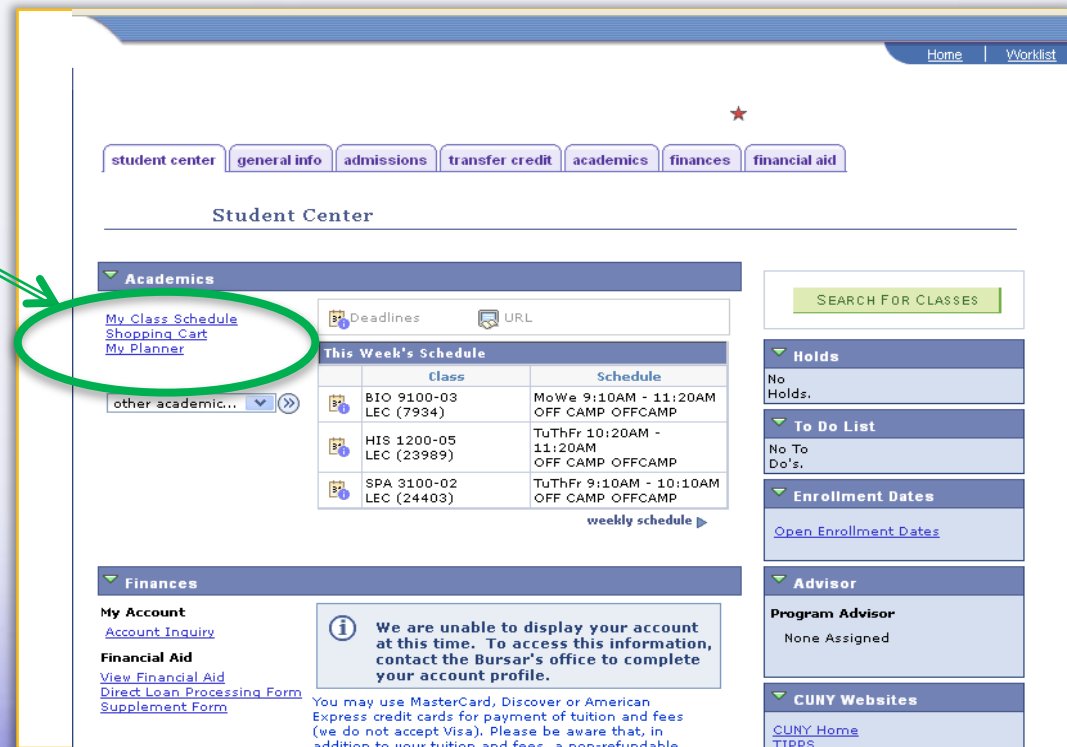
