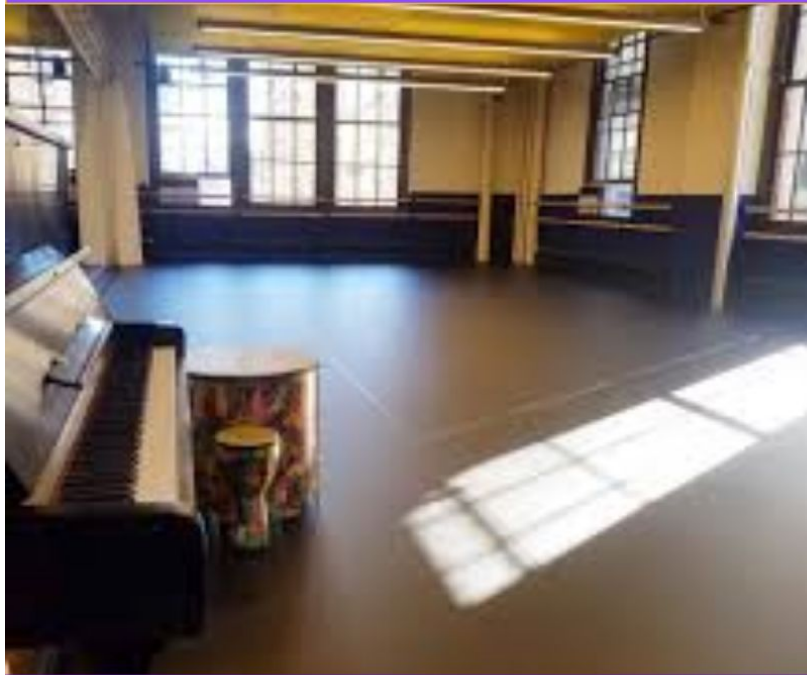

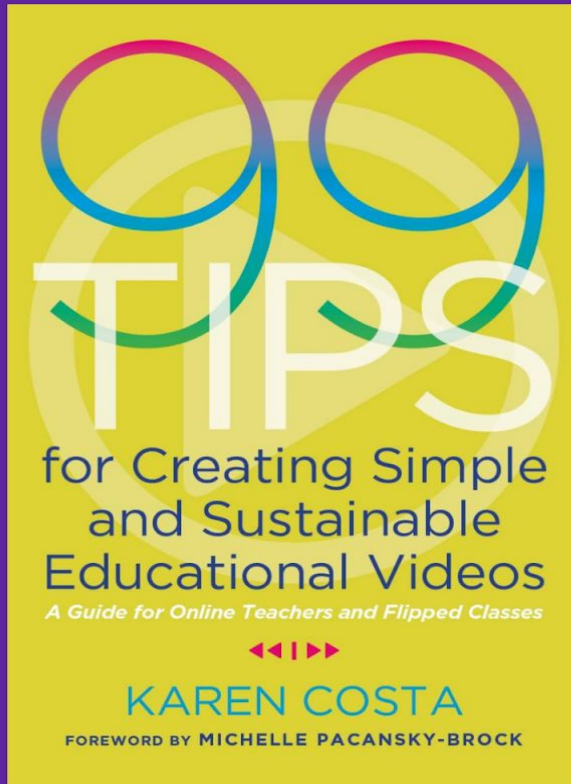

Beginning by outlining the different types of videos you can create, and what the research says about their effectiveness, Karen Costa explains how they can be designed to reinforce learning, to align with and promote course outcomes, and to save you time across your courses.

ALUMNI SPOTLIGHT - PEARL MARASIGAN

Pearl holds a Masters of Arts in Dance Education (2016)

What led her to Hunter College and what is she doing now?

Pearl grew up in Syracuse, New York, where she attended a rigorous ballet school, taking classes and rehearsing 3 hours per day for 6 days a week. She majored in dance at Hofstra University on Long Island and graduated a semester early in December of 2004. Dancing mainly modern dance was a big shift for her but it led to discovering her love of Limón and Graham-based modern, as well as West African dance. Following an independent study analyzing West African and Filipino folk dance, Pearl's mentor Dyane Harvey-Salaam encouraged her to continue her training in this dance form.



Pearl moved to Elmhurst, Queens, and held odd jobs including a dance teacher at multiple studios, a Starbucks barista, and a hostess (only once spilling red wine on a customer)! These jobs supported her as she trained, auditioned, rehearsed and performed all over NYC. She has performed for Beth Jacovy, Carol Nolte, Vissi Dance Theater, Beth Soll, Tamara Saari Dance Collective, Giada Ferrone, and performed in many showcases. She also co-founded HalloHallo, a dance theatre group committed to diversity and experimentation in dance.

In 2006 after substitute teaching a West African dance at Bard High School Early College Manhattan, Pearl was asked to return as a guest artist, which she used to help grow the dance program at Bard's Manhattan and Queens locations. In 2013 Pearl found a deep interest in capoeira (of which she continues to study to this day) and one year later, she began her MA in Dance Education at Hunter College. While at Hunter, one of her favorite classes was Dance History with Professor Nia Love, and she has continued this interest in studying both dance and culture. To Pearl, everything is dance. Her goal is to show her students how dance applies to everything in life, and that social activism, and the way you carry yourself are all forms of dance. Pearl's teaching methods allow her students to find themselves through dance, and to find a connection to movement in their own unique explorations in her class.

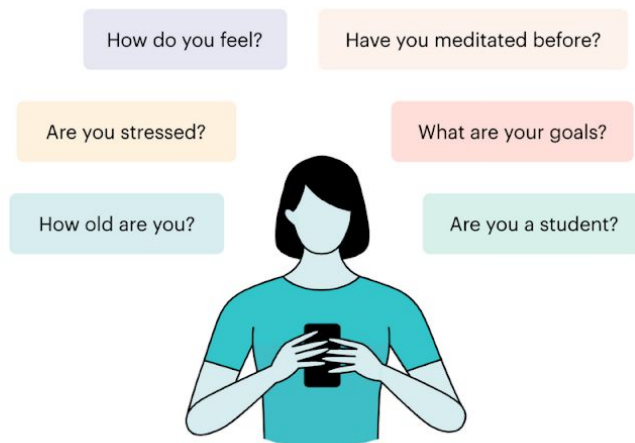
