## JPN 201 - INTERMEDIATE JAPANESE I - 中級日本語

Prerequisite: JPN 102 or equivalent

### **Course Description:**

Students will continue to develop their Japanese from the foundational skills established in the Beginning-level courses. The course focuses on extensive reading, writing, speaking, and listening practice. Advanced grammar, vocabulary, as well as additional Kanji will be covered.

# **Course Requirements:**

- Attendance is strictly monitored. No more than 3 absences are permitted before being penalized.
- Homework is assigned regularly. Please refer to the class schedule for weekly assignments.
- Chapter Quizzes focus primarily on the grammar points covered in the current chapter.
- **Kanji and Listening Quizzes** are taken after Chapter Quizzes and focus on the study of Chinese characters with an additional dictation and translation component as well.
- **Vocabulary Quizzes** are administered during the first five minutes of most classes.
- Midterm Presentations are group skits, consisting of 2-3 students. Perfect memorization is expected.
- Final Exam will cover material from the entire semester; focusing on grammar, reading, and writing.
