JPN 351 - ADVANCED JAPANESE CONVERSATION - 日本語会話

Prerequisite: JPN 202 or equivalent

Course Description:

This course is designed for students looking to become proficient in speaking Japanese in formal and informal situations. Speaking regularly in class is expected. Kanji radicals will also be covered.

This course will place particular emphasis on everyday Japanese speech patterns through regular speaking exercises. It will look at specific cultural factors to consider when speaking but mostly focus on helping students gain the ability to sound more natural in Japanese by placing them in scenarios that mimic the spontaneous nature of everyday conversations. Kanji radicals will gradually be introduced, a foundation that is hoped will aid in the further study of reading and writing Japanese.

Course Requirements:

- Attendance is strictly monitored. No more than 3 absences are permitted before being penalized.
- **Homework** is assigned regularly. Please refer to the class schedule for weekly assignments.
- Vocabulary Quizzes are quickly administered during the first five minutes of most classes.
- Themed Improvisation exercises pair students together to discuss a provided theme.
- Commercials are short, group skits where students will need to promote an assigned product.
- Kanji Projects will vary over the course of the semester but focus on highlighting the unique and fun aspects of Kanji.
