Universities restructured to fit into the neoliberal corporatization of America, through marginalization of faculty and violation of academic freedom

Decline in state funds for public education from 70% to teens, shift from direct funds to grants for individuals who can choose in the educational "marketplace," universities need to look elsewhere for money: research for private sector (with conflicts of interest), invited corporate marketing, increase tuition

Students as customers, amenities arms race, external consultants, recruited higher paying students, vocationally oriented programs, high profile faculty and sports coaches, outsourced services, technology MOOCs, replacing tenure faculty with part time instructors (75%), corporate style management
