

On December 15, 1950, the Port Authority Bus terminal was born which had been taken close to two years and \$24 million.

The Port Authority Bus Terminal which is located in the heart of Manhattan is the largest bus terminal in U.S. By 1939, the plan of construction was mentioned and the building was built in late 1950. It is also one of the busiest places in the world. The P.A said that 65million people passed through the terminal. In addition, as largest bus terminal, there are a travel bureau, a bakery, restaurants, a post office, etc in the building.
