
### INTRODUCTION

The National Center again presents its annual Directory of Faculty Contracts and Bargaining Agents in Institutions of Higher Education, this edition covering the period from April 1977 to February 1978.

As many observers have noted, the pace of faculty unionization has slowed during the past year. This may well be due to the budgetary stress that has befallen higher education. The reader, of course, examining the results of elections and decertifications as reported in these pages, may draw conclusions, but it would certainly be too early to predict any long-range trend.

That collective bargaining on the college campus is a continuing reality is obvious from the fact that more than 550 campuses in 343 institutions are now dealing with faculty bargaining agents. Moreover, the use of the strike weapon by instructional staff has made its appearance during the past year in leading institutions. It is safe to say that both administration and faculty will continue to be involved in the processes of collective bargaining.

The National Center believes that stable relationships between institutions and their personnel can be achieved only if both sides at the table bring with them an accurate knowledge of what is happening throughout the country. The data contained herein provide such a resource.


### STATISTICS (cont'd)

#### Note:

343 institutions (over 550 campuses) have elected bargaining agents to date. 19 institutions elected bargaining agents for the first time and 8 voted "No Agent" in the period covered by this update, April 1977 to February 1978. This is not reflected in the total number of bargaining agents (Chart I) when compared to last year's total since National Center statistics are computed by institution rather than by campus.

The following changes in institutional organization as well as bargaining unit inclusions account for this discrepancy.

- . 10 Massachusetts State Colleges now bargain as one unit with NEA as bargaining agent. Before this change in bargaining unit structure the AFT represented 3 institutions and the NEA represented 5.
- . 5 Illinois institutions now bargain collectively as one unit and the AFT which represented 5 colleges now represents all as one unit.
- . The University of the District of Columbia is a merger of 3 colleges formerly represented by NEA (2) and AFT (1). No bargaining agent has been selected since the merger.
- . The Florida Community Colleges voted to form a single statewide organization, reducing NEA by 1, and AFT by 2, and increasing UCCFF (Indep.) by 3.



# Legislative Activity in 1977

The figure is still 24 states with legislation permitting faculty collective bargaining. This past year several other states seriously considered extending legislation but all were defeated, and there has been no major activity in the south since Florida became the only southern state to pass legislation. A round-up of the major enabling legislative activity for the year follows:

### California


Assembly passed bill, but Senate education committee defeated measure to extend collective bargaining to 4-year institutions (community college legislation passed in 1975). Committee voted to reconsider compromise bill early in 1978. University of California and California State University and Colleges still opposed, with the latter considering setting up an internal system not reliant on legislation.

#### Colorado

No legislation, but some developments. Colorado Board of Community Colleges accepted as official results of faculty referendum in favor of collective bargaining at 9 state community colleges. This, after a series of events in which legislature appealed to courts the governor's veto of their rider to appropriations bill prohibiting use of funds for collective bargaining. Court dismissed appeal - leading to the faculty referendum. At University of Colorado, faculty council continues to study unionization.

#### Illinois

Two bills passed in House, but defeated in Senate. One of few states where faculty has been able to unionize without legislation, through agreement with Governing Boards. However, Southern Illinois University Board of Trustees recently refused to allow collective bargaining with faculty.



## Legislative Activity (cont'd)

### Indiana

Collective bargaining bill altered and amended so much that even proponents were against it and did not reach legislative vote. Indiana University (Bloomington) faculty council asked state legislature to enact legislation allowing representation vote.

### New York

Law passed requiring all members of bargaining units to pay agency fees to unions, whether they are members or not.

### Ohio


Compromise bill passed legislature, but vetoed by governor. They may try to override it and take new vote; if so, it won't take effect until 1979.

### Washington

Legislation to permit 4-year institutions to unionize passed by lower house but defeated by one vote in Senate. State law permits 2-year institutions to bargain and provides for non-academic staff in 4-year colleges to organize with limited number of topics bargainable.

## Wisconsin

Three bargaining bills for 4-year colleges rejected by state senate committee. (Legislation exists for 2-year institutions.)
University of Wisconsin Board of Regents support bill only if it limits bargaining to economic issues. University of Wisconsin faculty not united on bargaining bill - Madison campus opposed, other campuses support it.
