

INTRODUCTION

The annual <u>Bibliography</u> of the National Center continues to be recognized as an outstanding source of research material available in the field of collective bargaining in higher education and the professions. This seventeen volume series documents the development of collective bargaining in higher education as well as employment and labor relations issues for other professionals.

As the dimensions of unionized employment relationships undergoes changes, so do the various topics included in this project. Each year subjects are added or removed from the Bibliography dependent upon the amount of available research in any particular subject area. One emerging area is the impact of computers within the field of higher education collective bargaining and we have, therefore, included articles from this area. No articles were available this year on "due process" and, therefore, we deleted it from the subject areas listed in this volume. If research in this field increases, later editions may again include this topic.

This <u>Bibliography</u> is an annual accounting of the current state-of-the-art research and writings in collective bargaining in higher education and the professions. The research design and methodology used in the preparation of this volume relied on computer searches of various data bases. For publications not available through that format, manual retrieval of citations was employed. Sources include: books, monographs, dissertations, journals, periodicals, speeches and newspaper articles.

In addition to the Bibliography, the annual publications of the National Center

include the <u>Directory of Faculty Contracts and Bargaining Agents in Institutions of Higher Education</u>, <u>Proceedings</u> of our annual conference and a quarterly <u>Newsletter</u>. The Center also issues occasional monographs on selected topics. Our most recent publication is the <u>Directory of Non-Faculty Bargaining Agents in Institutions of Higher Education</u>. This <u>Non-Faculty Directory</u> will be updated periodically.

An impartial, nonprofit research institute of Baruch College of the City University of New York, the National Center serves as a clearinghouse and forum for those engaged in collective bargaining (and the related processes of grievance administration) in colleges and universities.

The publication of this <u>Bibliography</u> was a joint effort of the Center staff. Beth Johnson, the Administrative Coordinator of the Center, was responsible for the overall supervision and direction of this project as well as conducting primary data retrieval. Ruby Hill, the Center's Administrative Assistant, handled the computer inputting and production of this volume. We are most appreciative of their efforts which stand as a measure of their quality and success.
