**MASTER'S PROGRAM—ADULT GERONTOLOGY PRIMARY CARE NURSE PRACTITIONER**

The Hunter College School of Nursing of the City University of New York offers a 42-credit program to prepare Adult Gerontology Primary Care Nurse Practitioners, leading to a Master of Science degree. This program prepares graduates to provide primary care for adults and older adults in the community and in a variety of health care settings. Students learn to apply expert knowledge and research findings through 42 credits of coursework and 630 hours of supervised clinical experience. Graduates of the program are eligible for New York State NP certification and meet the educational requirements for national board certification by the American Nurses Credentialing Center and the American Academy of Nurse Practitioners Certification Program. They are also eligible for New York State certification as an Adult NP.

The program consists of core courses taken with other graduate students in nursing; advanced practice core courses; and an elective course.

Minimum requirements include:

- Graduation from an accredited baccalaureate program in nursing
- Licensure and current registration as an RN in New York State
- Cumulative undergraduate GPA of 3.0 overall and in nursing coursework
- Completion of a basic statistics course and an undergraduate research course
- Completion of an online application form including a personal statement and at least two relevant letters of recommendation
- 2 years post-baccalaureate full time registered nursing experience required

Please note that these are the minimum requirements; meeting them does not guarantee admission.
