

Adult Gerontology Primary Care NP (AGPCNP) Program Plan Fall Admit

The following is the program plan for the AGPCNP program. *If you cannot follow this sequence you must meet with Dr. Baumann to outline a specific plan.*

Clinical Requirements: Please be advised the clinical courses, Primary Care 1, 2, & 3 require completion of 210 precepted clinical hours during the semester. *Individual scheduling requests, ie weekend only, cannot be accommodated.* Students are expected to actively participate in identifying clinical sites and preceptors. *Students with restricted or specific scheduling needs must find their own placement that can accommodate their individual schedule.*

Health Clearance information is processed through CastleBranch. You will receive information about registering for an account in the semester prior to clinical.
