RE: Faculty Fellowship Publication Program (FFPP) 2014-2015

The Faculty Fellowship Publication Program (FFPP), sponsored by the Office of Recruitment and Diversity, is a University-wide initiative developed to assist full-time, untenured faculty in the design and execution of scholarly writing projects. Faculty selected for participation in the program will begin an intensive orientation this December. During the spring semester, participants will attend group sessions and one-on-one meetings with an assigned mentor for continued support of their writing projects.

Due to the rigorous program requirements, faculty chosen will receive three hours of reassigned time for the Spring 2015 semester. The reassigned time will be funded by the University. Since reassigned time will be provided, program participants must receive a letter of endorsement from the college provost and department chairperson.

Attached is the list of eligible faculty from your institution and the program announcement, which includes eligibility requirements, and the application cover sheet. My office has already notified those listed about the program and the application deadline of October 24, 2014.

The program is an integral component of the University's commitment to diversity. Although it is open to all faculty members who meet the eligibility requirements, CUNY's protected groups, including Italian Americans, are especially encouraged to apply.

Call for Proposals Academic Year 2014-2015

Deadline for Proposal Submission Friday October 24, 2014

PROGRAM PURPOSE & DESCRIPTION

The Faculty Fellowship Publication Program (FFPP) is sponsored by the Office of the Dean for Recruitment and Diversity in order to advance CUNY's institutional commitment to diversity. This University-wide initiative assists full-time untenured CUNY faculty (assistant professors) in the design and execution of writing projects essential to progress toward tenure. These projects may include research-based scholarly articles for juried journals, books for academic presses and creative writing projects. This program provides three credit hours of course release for the spring semester, a discipline-based writing group, and the guidance of a senior faculty member.

For the 2014-2015 academic year, FFPP Proposals are being accepted from eligible faculty in the following disciplines:

- Creative Writing/Film
- Education
- English
- Ethnic and Gender Studies
- Humanities
- Social Sciences

ELIGIBILITY

The faculty member may not be a past participant and must:

- Be an untenured assistant professor hired on a tenure-track line, on or between September 2008 and September 2013
- Be reappointed for academic year 2014-2015, and
- Have a doctorate or required terminal degree for teaching in their discipline (e.g., MFA for faculty in creative writing and/or film programs).

SUBMISSION DEADLINE & NOTIFICATION DATES

Submission deadline:on or before Friday October 24, 2014Notification of decision:Friday November 21, 2014

REVIEW & EVALUATION CRITERIA

The following parameters are considered when reviewing and evaluating FFPP Proposals.

- The overall quality, organization and clarity of the proposal
- The relevance and impact of the proposal to the applicant's discipline
- Prior work that demonstrates scholarly accomplishment
- Significance of the proposal to diversity and inclusion in higher education

PROGRAM TIMELINES

If your FFPP Proposal is accepted, you are required to attend the Orientation, Publishers' Roundtable and eight Writing Groups. Location is the CCNY Center for Worker Education at 25 Broadway, 7th floor, and dates are as follows:

- Orientation Friday December 12, 10am-2pm
- **Publishers' Roundtable** Friday March 27, 10am-1pm
- Writing Groups Friday January 30, February 13, February 27, March 13,

April 17, April 24, May 1, May 8; all meet at 10am-1pm

POST-PROGRAM EVALUATION

You will be expected to complete a brief survey that describes your experience with the program.

2. FFPP Proposal Components

- Proposal Title
- Abstract, 100 words
- **Diversity Statement**, 250 words, discussing your efforts toward fostering diversity in the academy through scholarship, creative projects, and/or work with students or faculty.
- **Proposal Narrative**, 750 to 1000 words
- A current Curriculum Vitae, and
- **Two Letters**, one from your department chair and one from your provost, supporting reassignment of three of your contractual teaching hours in the spring 2015 term to allow for your participation in the program. FFPP provides funding to campuses for adjunct coverage for those reassigned teaching hours.
