Psychology Minor Requirements

The minor program in Psychology is designed to expose students to a variety of content areas in the field of Psychology and to provide the student with the ability to evaluate Psychology researcher as a consumer.

To *declare* a Psychology minor, the student must have completed the following:

The *Minor* in Psychology consists of 15 credits in Psychology and 3 credits in Mathematics:

**Note:* You can still take psychology classes; a non-major can take anything from PSYCH 100-247 as long as all pre-requisites are met.
