Proposal for Change in Course Title

FROM: NURS 745/PAF 9793, Capstone Seminar for the MS/MPA in Nursing

TO: NUR 745, Leadership and Management in Health Care III

RATIONALE:

This course is the third of three specialization courses in the Nursing Administration/Public Administration program. The proposed title is more consistent with titles of other Master's specialization courses, and it clarifies that this course follows NURS 735, Leadership and Management in Health Care I and NURS 740, Leadership and Management in Health Care II.

Proposal for Change in Course Title

FROM: NURS 804, Finance and Management Practice Nursing

TO: NURS 804, Finance and Management of Advanced Practice Nursing

RATIONALE:

This is a required course for two tracks of the Doctor of Nursing Practice program. When the course was first proposed as part of the DNP program proposal, the title was apparently truncated inadvertently. The proposed title is what was intended and is more easily understood.

Proposal for a Change in Course Title

FROM: NURS 857, DNP Practice with Women

TO: NURS 857, Women's Health in Primary Care

Rationale/Justification:

This course is a requirement for students in the Adult/Gerontological Nurse Practitioner and Family Nurse Practitioner tracks in the Doctor of Nursing Practice program. The proposed title provides greater clarity regarding the focus of the course.
