**Meeting of the Hunter College Senate**  
**8 November 2000**

The 398th meeting of the Hunter College Senate was convened at 4:20 PM in Room W714.

**Presiding:** Pamela Mills, Chair

**Report by the President:** Provost Cohen read the following statement by President Gizis:

"I am sorry that a University obligation has precluded me from joining you this afternoon. However, I have asked Acting Provost Ann Cohen to share one message with you.

In my last address to you, I expressed my appreciation to the Select Committee on the Distribution Requirement for its excellent review of existing requirements and its recommendations for changes. A resolution adopting the committee's recommendations is before you today. I urge you to expeditiously evaluate and seriously consider these requirements, which will affect students entering Hunter in fall 2001."
