

**MINUTES**  
**Meeting of the Hunter College Senate**  
**10 February 1999**

The Chair stated that the new policy adopted by the Board of Trustees to phase out remediation in the senior colleges would affect Hunter in the fall of 2000.

She yielded the floor to Provost Gizis.

Provost Gizis provided data concerning the projected impact of the new policy on Hunter College (See Appendix III.)
