	The question of whether or not a quorum should be called for was raised by Prof. Korn, who noted the poor attendance of the meeting. It was pointed out by the Chair, that the only business of this overflow meeting were final items from the Undergraduate Course of Study Committee which had all unanimously been approved in that body and were therefore either routine or non-controversial, and that the catalogue deadline necessitated action by the Senate at this meeting in order that the students might have an up to date statement of what all departments were offering. Dean Eisenberg approved these sentiments, as did Deans Weyl and Freund.
