Review Commission on Distribution Requirement 46 Monica Safford - SGS 47 Eric Weissman - Day Student Alternate: Steven Vandor - Day 48 49 Prof. Gonchar then informed the Senate that the Administrative 50 Committee has charged the Nominating Committee with establishing 51 membership for the "ad-hoc Committee for the review of all adminis-52 trative practices which relate to the recruitment of students"(see 53 Minutes of October 5th, lines 25-30). She further informed the 54 Senate that membership for this committee will consist of 4 faculty 55 members and 4 students, and that anybody interested in serving on 56 this committee should contact the Nominating Committee c/o the 57 Senate Office. 58 Undergraduate Course of Study Committee 59 Prof. Robert July, Chairman of the Committee, presented the Report 60 dated October 5th re: "Proposals for Procedures for Implementing 61 Curricula Revisions," as distributed. 62 He then informed the Senate of the following corrections which should 63 be included in the Report: 64 Section 1. Routine Items/B. Appeals Procedure 65 Add item # 4: If ten members of the Senate indicate on signed 66 petition to the Chairman of the Senate that an item has been 67 improperly identified as routine, that item shall be referred to 68 the Senate for discussion and determination of definition. 69 Footnote on page 1 / Routine Items 70 Change footnote to read: Routine Items shall consist of courses and 71 programs previously approved by the Senate which require alteration 72 in form such as course number and title, or course description, 73 leaving unaltered the essential character of the course of program 74 in question. Substantive: All other items shall be regarded as 75 substantive. 76 Section 2.1 Substantive Items/ A. Standard Procedure
Change item # 2 to read: All Senators, department chairpersons 77 78 and members of the appropriate college course of study committee 79 shall be apprised through circulation of course descriptions of 80 those items ready for final consideration by the Divisional 81 Curriculum Committee or committees. 82 Section 2.1 Substantive Items/ B. Appeal Procedure 83 Delete item # 4 and substitute the following for item #3: 84 3. After debate, the Senate shall either approve or reject the 85 proposal in question, or return it to the Undergraduate Course 86 of Study Committee for final revision under Senate instruction. 87 The Chair then proposed that, in order to facilitate free discussion, 88 this body move into a Committee of the Whole for 1/2 hour. 89 There being no objection it was so ordered, and at 5 p.m. the meeting 90 reconvened as a Committee of the Whole. 91 The Senate reconvened in formal session at 6:15 p.m. 92 After brief discussion it was moved and seconded that the meeting 93 time be extended to 7 p.m. 94 The motion was defeated with a vote of 32 in favor and 40 opposed. 95 Prof. Bennick moved that Section 2.1 A. 7. be amended by changing 96 it to read: 97 Items approved by the course of study committee shall be 98 identified for information purposes on the Senate Agenda, and . 99 the Committee's action shall become final unless appealed 100

(see Section B.).

This amendment was accepted by the mover and became part of the main motion.	102 103
Prof. Bennick then moved that the report be further amended by deleting the word "final" in Section 2.1 B. 3.	104 105
After discussion, and in view of the late hour, it was agreed that a revised report including all corrections and amendment be made available for the next meeting.	106 107 108
