<u>Joint Committee on Undergraduate Academic Requirements and Student Standing</u>	17 18
Prof. Peter Basquin, Chairman of the Committee, presented its report and proposed the following two resolutions:	19 20
1. RESOLVED, that this reserves to departments the right to exclude the choice of credit/no credit grading in the specified cases: namely, where their own majors are concerned, and only for courses required for the major. If the department does not formally move to exclude this option, the student has the right to choose it, subject to the various restrictions and considerations detailed in the Students' Guide. If it is necessary to close the credit/no credit option for some or all courses, the department faculty should formally move to do so, and should make known to its students through the undergraduate advisor and departmental bulletin boards* what the restrictions are and what the sanctions may be if students should use the options incorrectly. Non-majors are not to be affected by this. The several professional and pre-professional programs may also place similar restrictions on students in their program.	21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34 35 36
