Report by the President:	In the absence of the President and Provost, Dean Walter Weiss informed the Senate that last week President Shalala, Provost LeMelle, Vice-President Tesoriero and Assistant Vice-President Smith went to Albany to formally present Hunter's budget request for next year. Albany seems to be quite confused and uncertain about the implications, for next year's State budget, of the budget cuts and fiscal rearrangements being made in Washington. Hunter's budget request includes an additional 23 instructional lines, some support lines, and a sizeable number of lines for maintenance and operations relating to the new buildings.
