Because of the absence of the Chairperson of the Committee on Proficiency in English Composition, the next item of business was Agenda item 5, Report by the Student Standing Committee.	28 29 30
<u>Student Standing Committee</u> Prof. Sam Korn, Acting Chairperson of the Committee, presented the Report as distributed.	31 32 33
No questions having been raised, the Report was received.	34
<u>Committee on Proficiency in English Composition</u> Prof. Allan Brick, in the absence of Prof. Tannenbaum, presented the Report as submitted.	35 36 37
He reminded the Senate that the motion on the floor was the following amendment proposed by Prof. Flashner at the October 24th Senate meeting:	38 39
"that the last part of the last sentence of resolution 4 be deleted (lines 93 and 94 of the Report), so that the report end with the words 'these goals' on line 93."	40 41 42

After discussion, Prof. Kirwan moved that resolution 4 be amended by inserting the word "generally" after the word 'cannot' on line 89. 43
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This insertion was accepted and unanimously agreed to by the body. 45

After further discussion the question was called and carried on Prof. Flashner's amendment. 46
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The amendment (lines 40 to 42 above) was defeated by hand vote with 9 in favor, 35 opposed, and 4 abstentions. 48
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After discussion Prof. Sherover moved that the Report be amended by adding a paragraph "G" to resolution 3 (between lines 87 and 88 of the Report). 50
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Prof. Benardete moved the following wording for paragraph G, which was accepted by Prof. Sherover. 53
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G. The Committee shall review and reconsider the standards now established for the present exit examinations for 17.120. 55
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After discussion the question was called and carried. 57

The motion to amend carried by hand vote. 58

After discussion, Prof. Korn moved that resolution 4 of the Report be further amended on Line 93 by inserting the words "...as an additional criterion in making..." 59
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The question was called and carried and the motion to amend carried by hand vote. 62
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Resolution 4 of the Report as amended (see lines 43-44 and 59-61 above) now reads: 64
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4. Instructors heavily loaded in terms of contact hours and student numbers cannot generally take on additional work in the assigning and teaching of student writing while continuing to fulfill other professional responsibilities. 66
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Therefore, the college administration is urged strongly to support the foregoing resolutions, in the future to make available funds for the implementation of these goals, and to consider faculty involvement in such activities as an additional criterion in making personnel decisions. 70
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The motion on the floor was approval of resolutions 1 through 4 as amended. 75

A motion to divide the question carried. 76

The motion to approve resolution 1 was on the floor. 77

The question was called and carried, and resolution 1 of the Report was approved by hand vote. 78
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The next item of business was approval of resolution 2. 80

After discussion, a motion to recommit resolution 2 carried by hand vote. 81


The motion to approve resolution 3 as amended (see lines 50-56 above) was on the floor. 82

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The question was called and carried, and the motion to recommit resolutions 3 and 4 as amended carried by hand vote. 86
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A motion to adjourn carried, and the meeting was adjourned at 6:15 p.m. 88
