

INFORMATION REGARDING PLACEMENT INTO MATHEMATICS AND STATISTICS COURSES (effective October, 2019)

Students must demonstrate that they meet college readiness in mathematics as outlined by the City University of New York (CUNY) at the time of application. Furthermore, **students must achieve certain scores on the Hunter College Math Placement Test (MPT) to qualify for mathematics and statistics courses at Hunter College, with the exception of MATH 10000, MATH 10200 or STAT 11000.** Questions regarding the administration of the MPT should be directed to the Testing Center via email at testing@hunter.cuny.edu or in Room 150 Hunter North.

If you need to take a math/stat course for your course of study, you **may take course “x”** if you have the following scores:

Note:- STAT 11300 may be used as a prerequisite for STAT 21200.</i></p> <p>MATH 12400 <i>Note: This course is for students who do not intend to take calculus.</i></p> <p>MATH 12550 <i>Note: This course is for students who intend to take calculus.</i></p> <p>MATH 12500 (for newly accepted transfer students only) <i>Note: This course may be used as a prerequisite for MATH 15000, 15200, 16000, STAT 21200 and STAT 21300.</i></p>	<p>A score of 51 or above out of 65 on parts 1 & 2</p>
<p>Math Level 2 (includes all courses in Math Level 1):</p> <p>MATH 14000 <i>Note: This is a corequisite for MATH 1500 and MATH 15200 for students who took MATH 12400 or MATH 12500 or who get below B- in MATH 12550</i></p> <p>MATH 15000, MATH 15200 <i>Note: Check the Hunter College Course Catalog for additional prerequisite and co-requisite requirements.</i></p> <p>STAT 21200, 21300</p>	<p>A score of 53 or above out of 65 on parts 1 & 2 And A score of 21 or above out of 30 on part 3</p>

GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE HUNTER COLLEGE MATH PLACEMENT TEST (MPT)

The MPT is a timed, multiple choice, computer-based test. Calculators are **not** allowed to be used while taking the exam.
